

Notes for teachers.

This resource has 20 questions. These need to be printed and cut up and can be laminated. Stick them up round the room and pupils go round answering the multiple choice questions on their sheets. They can work in pairs and start from anywhere in the room and answer the questions in any order.

The punchline for the joke comes out in code. This stops pupils guessing the answer based on what letter they think will come next. To decipher the message, advance each letter on one in the alphabet so A becomes B, B becomes C, etc. Z becomes A. Punctuation stays as it is. You can give this information to each pair as they finish or wait until everyone has finished which avoids an early finisher blurting out the answer and demotivating those still working on the activity. You can use the PowerPoint to go through the questions one by one.
