Question Marks（？）
You use a question mark at the end of a sentence．It is used instead of a full stop．

Example，
How are you feeling today？

## Speech Marks（＂n）

Speech marks are used to show what someone is saying or what they have said．They go at the beginning and end of the speech．
For example，
＂I told you not to do that！＂said the teacher．
